

# COVID-19 VACCINE SUPPORT UPDATED VACCINATION SCHEDULES



As the pandemic continued, we've seen vaccination options develop and expand to become more accessible to children. As of recently, Moderna and Pfizer in smaller doses are available to children as young as 6 months. Take a look at the CDC's updated vaccination schedules for children between the ages of 6 months to 17 years old.

## PFIZER VACCINE SCHEDULE FOR CHILDREN & TEENS

### CHILDREN (6 MONTHS - 4 YEARS)

- PRIMARY SHOT (1ST DOSE)
- PRIMARY SHOT (2ND DOSE) - 3 TO 8 WEEKS AFTER 1ST DOSE
- BOOSTER SHOT (3RD DOSE) - AT LEAST 8 WEEKS

### CHILDREN (5 - 11 YEARS)

- PRIMARY SHOT (1ST DOSE)
- PRIMARY SHOT (2ND DOSE) - 3 TO 8 WEEKS AFTER 1ST DOSE
- BOOSTER SHOT (3RD DOSE) - AT LEAST 5 MONTHS AFTER 2ND DOSE

### CHILDREN (12 - 17 YEARS)

- PRIMARY SHOT (1ST DOSE)
- PRIMARY SHOT (2ND DOSE) - 3 TO 8 WEEKS AFTER 1ST DOSE
- BOOSTER SHOT (3RD DOSE) - AT LEAST 2 MONTHS AFTER 2ND DOSE OR LAST BOOSTER ONLY WITH THE PFIZER VACCINE.

## MODERNA VACCINE SCHEDULE FOR CHILDREN & TEENS

### CHILDREN (6 MONTHS - 11 YEARS)

- PRIMARY SHOT (1ST DOSE)
- PRIMARY SHOT (2ND DOSE) - 4 TO 8 WEEKS AFTER 1ST DOSE
- BOOSTER SHOT (3RD DOSE) - MODERNA DOESN'T RECOMMEND A BOOSTER SHOT FOR CHILDREN AND TEENS IN THIS GROUP YET.

### CHILDREN (12 - 17 YEARS)

- PRIMARY SHOT (1ST DOSE)
- PRIMARY SHOT (2ND DOSE) - 4 TO 8 WEEKS AFTER 1ST DOSE
- BOOSTER SHOT (3RD DOSE) - AT LEAST 2 MONTHS AFTER 2ND DOSE OR LAST BOOSTER ONLY WITH THE PFIZER VACCINE.

## NOVAVAX VACCINE SCHEDULE FOR CHILDREN & TEENS

### CHILDREN (12 - 17 YEARS)

- PRIMARY SHOT (1ST DOSE)
- PRIMARY SHOT (2ND DOSE) - 3 TO 8 WEEKS AFTER 1ST DOSE
- BOOSTER SHOT (3RD DOSE) - AT LEAST 2 MONTHS AFTER 2ND DOSE OR LAST BOOSTER ONLY WITH THE PFIZER VACCINE.
